Jago Hua Savera deals with the struggles of an impoverished family living in a fishing village in present-day Bangladesh (then Pakistan). The film focuses on the human spirit that can endure any kind of hardships. The family members in the film are shown trying to get money to buy a boat they need to sustain their livelihood but the hopelessness of their objective is graphically underscored by the conditions in which they live, and the self-interest of the local moneylender. The film is at times poetic and is a commentary on society that is relevant even today.
